1 Chron 29:10-14

1. What encouraged, struck or challenged you in the teaching from God's word on Sunday?
2. The Bible has a lot to say on the topic of money – so it must be important! What are your initial reactions to having this sermon series on money? In what ways do you think it could help and encourage you in following Jesus? What could a reformed relationship with money look like for you?
3. **"It's not your money"**
In 1 Chronicles 29:10-14, King David praises God for His greatness and ownership of everything. How does acknowledging that everything we have belongs to God lead to praise and trust in him?
4. **"It's in your hands"**
How does this passage show God's generosity towards us? (Look as well at 1 Cor 4:7.) How will that lead to humble thanksgiving?
5. We talked about the difference between asking "what should I do with my money?" and "what should I do with his money that he's given me to use"? How does that shift help as you think about your relationship with what you have?
