## 1 Timothy 6:6-19

1. What encouraged, struck or challenged you in the teaching from God's word on Sunday?
2. In what ways can we view money as the secret to living a "life that is truly life"?
3. The passage speaks to "those who want to get rich" v9 and "those who are rich in this present age" v17. Do you see yourself as one or other of those groups (or both!)?
4. In v7-10 how is money shown to be both **temporary** and a **trap**?
5. How will "pursuing righteousness" (v11) above all change our relationship to money and lead to "godliness with contentment" (v6)?
6. In v17 the rich are commanded not to be arrogant. How can wealth make us arrogant towards others? And towards God?
7. How can people "put their hope in wealth which is so uncertain"?
8. How will putting our hope instead in our generous God (v17) lead us to be generous and willing to share?
9. How can wealth help us to be rich in good deeds?
